

# ***Reincarnation: A Truth Deleted***

A Message from Jeshua  
to Nick and his supporters

We are on the topic, for the moment, of core teachings and distortions. Well there are core teachings that I would like to bring forth and distortions that I would erode. That is a good term. I would erode some of those distortions to the bedrock of the teaching.

I would like to speak now of reincarnation.

## **Reincarnation In Context**

This concept, reincarnation, makes sense only within the context of a spark of the Divine which resides inside everyone. This spark is in fact born young into the dense world of physical incarnation. Over many lifetimes it matures until it becomes a spiritual source radiating light and love into the world – a mini star, a tiny fragment of God walking the Earth, manifesting the light and love and compassion attributes of our Creator.

It has been said many times: “As above, so below.” Well this is: “As below, so above,” so to speak, because a child is born an infant and grows into its maturity. Thus is the spark of God when it first incarnates into dense physical matter, it is as an infant.

The infant matures over time, over many incarnations, over many cycles of:

- incarnation,
- between life state of assessment and decision and planning for the next life,
- then going once again into incarnation.

Over the eons, with each cycle, the spark of the Divine matures. Well, hopefully, if you allow me another little humor, hopefully each incarnation cycle brings maturing.

One can think of this in a profession. Pick a profession. I will pick on lawyers. There is a difference between five years of legal experience and one year of experience five times over.

And thus it is with the incarnating soul. The soul can learn and grow and have five lifetimes of experience, or the soul can attempt to live a glorious lifetime five times over. Let us assume, however, that we have a reasonable maturation rate.

Over these cycles, the soul matures until it reaches a state that is analogous to where I was when I walked the Earth of Jeshua of Nazareth. I happened to be bringing a specific message to the human race when I reached that state of maturity. I am hardly the first soul to reach that state of maturity and there have been those come after me who have reached that state of maturity. They didn't happen to be carrying the message I was carrying. They brought humanity other gifts.

Each one of us who has reached that level of maturity has continued to learn and continued to grow – ever a teacher, ever a student. I believe I have said this to you. You never stop being a teacher and you never stop being a student until such time as you are fully reunited with the Creator God.

### **Without Reincarnation Perspective Changes**

Now when the concept of reincarnation is stripped from the holy words and the holy texts, the perspective changes. The teachings change. Because once that underpinning has been removed – I shake my head.

Once that underpinning is removed you are left with threats of hell; you are left with carrots – heaven. You are left with the necessity to judge.

You are left with the concept that there is, in all of time – in all of time there is this one tiny moment, one *tiny* span that you must prove yourself regardless of the situation you are born into, regardless of what is going on in your community, be it revolution or a time of peace, be it a time of suppression of individuality and creativity or a time of enrichment – that there is in the entire time span of creation one tiny fragment that you are given to prove your worth, to make your decisions, to settle your fate for the rest of eternity.

Now I'm sure that there are those among you where you can pinpoint a time when one decision made in a nanosecond has influenced the rest of your life, because those decisions happen. Those decisions are faced by many.

To assume that a loving and just Creator would give created souls less than one second in the span of eons – well it does not make sense to me. I will leave it up to you as to whether that makes sense to you. But that is the logical approach.

What does your heart say of justice? What does your heart say about this concept of once around when some are born into situations so vastly different from what another is born into?

Now introduce into this apparent gross inequity of beginnings of life, introduce the concept reincarnation, introduce the fact that each incarnated human being is a spirit experiencing a life. There were lives preceding this one and there will be lives after this one. (I am not going to talk about the beginning of the beginning or the end of the end at this point. I might at some time, but not now.)

Add to this the fact that each soul is responsible for its own maturation and its own forward progress.

Add to this the fact that there is a spark of God that comes into incarnation with every soul and we are back to what I spoke of last time: original sin versus free will, karmic history and soul intentions.

### **Reincarnation and Free Will**

A soul can come in with the finest of intentions, but the manifested being has free will. So let us take for instance the soul may have chosen deliberately to come into existence into very difficult, stressful circumstances. Let's say a country under an oppressive ruler. That certainly seems to be modern enough, pertinent enough. And this soul coming into this country at a very difficult and crucial time in this country's history had intentions of peacefully freeing the people of this country. That could be the soul intentions.

The incarnated individual, however, may have looked around and seen the oppression and seen the restrictions and seen the result of speaking out and decided, "That's not for me. I'm not going there. I'm not risking that. I have my family to think of. My parents, my children. Yes, I would like to

“speak out, but I’m not going to.”

That is a free will decision. The soul may have intended one thing but free will took another direction.

And let us say that when that life ends and the soul makes an assessment of what it intended versus what it accomplished and it works with its colleagues and says: “We’re gonna try again next time. We’re going right back into the same country and we’re going to try and make an improvement and I think we can do it this time.”

Now I am not saying that is what happens. I am playing out a simple scenario of what *could* happen to demonstrate what incredible opportunities the truth of reincarnation offers individuals to grow, to demonstrate the Divinity within, offering again and again the opportunity to make decisions that will light up humanity and move humanity forward.

### **Reincarnation: Free Pass? Or Opportunity?**

Now there are those who say: “My goodness, we can’t have reincarnation because if we have reincarnation why everyone would go out and act like the prodigal son. Why bother if we’re going to get another round? I’m just going to go out and whatever. Let next life worry about paying for it.”

Now how many of you are ready to judge that decision?

Then I would ask how many of you think you have never *made* that decision?

But I would argue to those who decry reincarnation for that reason that the argument is just as strong the other way – that there are those souls who are saying: “My word! There is a problem. I seem to have this problem with. . . .” Name it. Losing my temper.

Looking at the environment I can say one of two things. I can say, “Well let the environment go to waste. I don’t care. It isn’t going to get cleaned up before I go so why worry about it.” Or one can look at the environment and say, “I would like to clean it up because not only will my children be coming into this in the future, I myself might be coming into this in the future.”

That is a selfish way of looking at it perhaps, but it works. You may decide that you want to break some habit that has carried over from your past and comes into this life because of karmic history and you want to settle some karmic debt. And you want to do it now, in this life, so that it's taken care of so your future life – not your children, but your own future life – can begin in a better place.

That kind of decision is just as probable as is the decision to say, "What the heck. I'm not going to face the consequences, that's the next life." The decision to say, "I am laying the foundation for a better next life," is just as probable.

Those who argue against reincarnation and say it's not in the Bible, well, they are right. Once you strip something out, it's very hard to get it back.

### **Cultural Memory**

For all humanity's historic records, cultural memory is very short, very short indeed. Once a piece of information comes in or goes out humanity has great flexibility – both as individuals and as a culture – to fill the gap of what was removed or to include what was added. This flexibility is awesome. In a blink any change can be treated as if it has always been that way. That is why your wise historians are so valuable.

If you think this is not true, ask any child what it was like without – and you can fill in a piece of technology here. Cellphones. Television.

Ask any adult what it was like without airplanes – air transportation. I think you get my meaning.

How many of you supporters of Nick, I do not know all your age ranges, how many of you are from the United States and can remember when the pledge of allegiance was changed? And how many of you know what that change was?

You see words were added. Words were added and those added words quickly became such an integral part of the culture that I would be willing to bet the vast majority of citizens of the United States would be shocked if

those words were now removed. This happened within the living memory of many alive today. So we are talking what? One generation. We're talking one single generation and that change is totally accepted.

I use that as an example. Those of you who are not in the United States perhaps you can ask someone who knows what I am talking about.<sup>1</sup>

So when you remove words from holy texts, or texts that are considered holy, texts that are used and relied upon to guide the spiritual lives of humanity and you strip those texts of a concept, it does not take very long at all, for all of humanity to assume that that concept is alien, is unholy. Add to the removal of this concept, those who would deliberately teach that this concept is wrong, is alien, is heresy, is sacrilege. Pick a word. So you remove the words from the text. You go on what amounts to a marketing campaign to vilify anyone who would conceive of retaining that concept as part of their world view and this concept is gone. It's gone.

And generations later people with loving hearts and the intention to live a holy life, the intention to live a good and righteous life will not believe that that concept could possibly have existed ever, because it is not in the book that they use, the book that their spiritual teachers use to guide their development. It is very easy to eliminate. And it is just as easy to insert. But it can be very difficult to *re-insert* what has been eliminated. Yet that is what must be done.

Now I have gone on far too long.

This happens to be one of my hot buttons, as I'm sure you have guessed by now. Restoring the concept of reincarnation as you move forward with your bridge of truth, as your Foundation moves forward with its truth, restoring this concept is problematic. Your allies I would suggest are very likely in the mystic community.

There are those who have and are bringing forth and attempting, thru intellectual and dedicated research, to restore reincarnation to the Christian faith. Find them. Work with them. Enlist them in your cause.

**Consider Starting With Reincarnation**

If you are tackling one thing and only one issue as a plank in your bridge, as a starting point, consider the concept of reincarnation because once that is introduced, as I pointed out last time, original sin takes on a different perspective. Once reincarnation is re-introduced, "the only begotten son of God" takes on a new perspective.

You are the ones who must know where to start. You know your own climate, you know your own strengths, you know your own limitations, you know your own strategy. You know yourselves; you know your group.

But I would ask you to consider starting with reincarnation. Build such a bridge that in essence reincarnation can be restored as a foundational teaching in such a way that the transition is as easy as possible for the believers and that those who maintain the inner teachings of the church are not personally blamed for the exclusion of reincarnation. Because I am here to tell you that those of you now working with Nick may very well have been or had lives in which you yourself called reincarnation heresy. Do not be quick to judge. You may have spent lives persecuting those who claimed reincarnation. I am not saying you did. Please to not think that. All I am saying is that it is possible. It is possible.

As angry you might get if you feel anger, as frustrated as you might get if frustration is your expression, reach into your hearts and find the Christ Consciousness within yourself and view the broader perspective.

For 2000 years – give or take – the elimination of this one truth, this reincarnation truth, has created many distortions. You will find the distortions built upon the "fact" that there is only one life to live. Be kind to yourselves. Be kind to those who find themselves picking up "truths" they were given, having no reason to doubt them, and perpetuating them.

Give them a way to move forward that does not involve your judgment of them. And if you – I am smiling – if you were not one in any your lives who perpetuated this falsehood, who denied reincarnation, then maybe one of your best friends was in that boat. Think of your friend and be kind.

That would be my recommendation. Not that you do this, but that you

consider this. And as you consider the truths, the core truths, the core teachings, and the distortions, those you recognize in your own hearts as distortions, do a little analysis. Listen to your hearts as if you were unwinding a tangled ball of string, see if you can find a core teaching – if not a teaching – a core assumption, an assumption about the way humanity's spirituality evolves. Reincarnation was more an assumption than a teaching. And if you can get to underlying assumptions as well as core teachings, then some of these other issues will begin to unravel.

I have gone on plenty long enough. That is my message to you at this point in time.

Once again, I thank you. I encourage you. I encourage you to move forward with love and compassion and as builders of a bridge that will move both the church and its many supporters and believers into the light of original truths, truths free of the shadows that have grown over time because of what was added and what was taken away.
